ARRIVAL: May begin arriving **NO EARLIER** than 8:00 a.m. on Friday, October 9, 2009.

IN PLACE: Must be in place on Friday, October 9, 2009 at 12:00 noon.

DRAFT HORSE HALTER: Friday, October 9, 2009 at 2:00 p.m in the Mustang Arena

DRAFT HORSE HITCHES: Friday, October 9, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Ford Truck Arena

DRAFT HORSE SHOW: Saturday, October 10, 2009 at 8:00 a.m. in the Ford Truck Arena

RELEASED: At the conclusion of the show on Saturday, October 10, 2009.

ENTRY DEADLINE: August 28, 2009. Horse Show entries may be mailed in on official entry form or entered online. Entries mailed must be postmarked by **August 28**. Entries submitted online must be completed by 12:00 midnight, August 28.

ENTRY EXTENSION: Entries received prior to August 28 are able to add additional animals and classes at double head fees and double class fees until **September 18, 2009**.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries not received prior to August 28 can enter until **September 18, 2009** for triple head fees and triple class fees.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon, the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **SANCTIONING:** All horses are subject to the rules and regulations set up by the Oklahoma Draft Horse and Mule Association and the Tulsa State Fair.
2. **IMPORTANT INFORMATION** - The Tulsa State Fair will not accept any entry unless it is accompanied by the required fees, photocopies of registration papers, and the appropriate social security number.
 - A. Omission of requested information, invalid or incorrect information or insufficient checks will result in entry being disqualified.
 - B. No premiums will be paid if not provided with a social security number.

3. **DRAFT HORSE FEES:**

Horse (per head).	\$40.00
Tack Stall (if available).	\$40.00
Class entry fee	\$10.00
Additional Exhibitor Tickets (Book of 5) optional	\$25.00

Additional tickets may be purchased in the Livestock Office or in the Credentials Trailer located at Gate 7.

NOTE: Each exhibitor will receive a 1 pass per horse, limited to 4 passes, good for 5 days at the fair.
4. **GATE 7:** All livestock **MUST** enter through gate 7. Gate 7 will be open from 6:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m. Health Papers will be checked upon arrival and exhibitor tickets will be available to pick up in the trailer at gate 7.
5. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** A copy of registration papers must be sent on all registered horses. If no papers are sent and horse is entered in halter class it will be entered in the gelding class. First place mares, stallions and geldings of all breeds to combine for Grand/Reserve Mare, Stallion and Gelding.
6. **STALLING:** All horses must stall and pay head fee.
7. **TRAILERS:** All livestock trailers must be parked in the off-site lot designated for trailers. No trailers will be allowed to park on the grounds.
8. **LADIES' & MENS NOVICE CART CLASSES** - You may enter this class only two years. **THE SAME DRIVER MAY NOT ENTER JUNIOR, NOVICE AND REGULAR CART CLASS THE SAME YEAR.**
9. **HITCH CLASSES** - The hitch classes are considered group classes. More than one owner may participate in a hitch class but only one owner should make the entry and pay the entry fee for the team. Only one driver is permitted in any of the classes. One rider is optional.
10. **FARM & LOGGING CLASSES:**
 - A. Must use farm harness-no hame housings, scotch collars or patent leather
 - B. No manes or tails braided.
 - C. Wagon will be furnished for a Farm Team Obstacle class.
 - D. Horse Drawn Farm Machinery. Open to any age exhibitor and any number of horses. Open to any machinery used on the farm or ranch, wheeled or drawn. The judge will direct each exhibitor to perform within the capabilities of their machinery.

11. SHOW HITCH CLASSES:

- A. An adult must ride with junior cart drivers.
- B. Show hitches must have a fifth wheel wagon.

12. SINGLE CART OBSTACLE, SINGLE HORSE LOG OBSTACLE, FEED TEAM RACE, TEAM WAGON OBSTACLE AND LOG OBSTACLE information and layout of course will be given out at exhibitor meeting.

13. COSTUME CLASS theme to be "Spooky": A 2 or 4 wheel vehicle may be driven. (Does not have to be antique vehicle.) A horse may be ridden or walked. Farm or show harness may be used. All costumes should be theme related.

14. PLEASURE DRIVING CLASS does not require show harness, show shoes, or braids and will be judged on the appearance of being a "relaxing pleasure to drive." **NOTE:** Draft Horse Show participants are encouraged to attend a meeting at the ODHMA Hospitality Booth Friday, October 9, 10:00 a.m.
