**Draft Horse Pull Rules and Regulations
TWO CLASS OVER WEIGHT**

SCHEDULE

ARRIVAL: All horses must be on the grounds by weigh-in closing time - 10:00 a.m., Saturday, October 10, 2009.

WEIGH IN: Saturday, October 10, 2009 between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. All Horses Weigh.

LIGHT HORSE PULL: Saturday, October 10, 2009 at 2:00 p.m.

HEAVY HORSE PULL: Saturday, October 10, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.

RELEASE: Release to leave the grounds will be issued after the Draft Horse Pull Contest.

Pulls will occur in this order. It's the contestant's responsibility to be on time.

Teams must weigh 3,000 pounds and over. No Exceptions.

ENTRY DEADLINE: August 28, 2009. Entries may be mailed in on official entry form or submitted online. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 28. Entries submitted online must be completed by 12:00 midnight, August 28.

ENTRY EXTENSION: Entries received prior to August 28, 2009, are able to add additional teams at double the fee until **September 18, 2009.**

LATE ENTRIES: Entries that were not received prior to August 28, 2009, can enter until **September 18, 2009**, for triple the fees.

1. **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS:** NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS SUBMITTED WITH ENTRY.
2. **WEIGHING:** Weigh in with be from 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. Official Scales furnished by Paul's Scales.
3. **CLASS BREAKS:** Classes will be split equally between the Light and Heavy Horse Pulls. Should the pull have an odd number of entries, the extra team will pull in the Heavy Horse Pull.
4. This is a fifteen (15) foot overload pull, with driver riding seld.
5. Each team has three (3) pulls: the total distance counts.
6. All pulls must be made within a 15 foot lane.
7. No striking or whipping of the horses will be allowed.
8. All horses are subject to testing for use of stimulant and/or drugs.
9. Use of profanity and/or intoxicating beverages will disqualify entry.
10. Drivers furnish doubletrees and helpers; helpers stay behind doubletree. Drivers will be allowed a back up on line.
11. No heading will be allowed.
12. No open bridles or changing of sides will be permitted.
13. In case of break down, sled goes back to starting point if driver desires another pull. Reasonable time will be allowed for repairs.
14. Three attempts to hook equals one pull.
15. Sled will be furnished by Tulsa State Fair.
16. Any team not under control of the driver (runaways) will be disqualified.
17. Draft Horse Pull processing fees: \$40.00 per team
(One pass will be given per team entered.)
