Entry Deadline: Entries must be submitted online by August 27, 2010. Legal Release Form, Online Receipt, and Payment must be mailed in and postmarked by September 3, 2010.

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple the fees.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All changes to the rules for 2010 are in bold print

1. **READ RULES AND REGULATIONS:** Exhibitor must comply with the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and the Health and Sanitary Regulations in the front of this book as well as Junior Division Rules and Regulations.
2. **ELIGIBILITY: NEW! The Tulsa State Fair Breeding Gilt Show and Sale is limited to Oklahoma Youth. Youth who are five by July 1, 2010 and have neither graduated from high school before May 2010 nor reached their 19th birthday before January 1, of the year of the show will be eligible to show. The exhibitor must be able to control their gilt and show the gilt by their self without assistance from someone else in the ring.**
3. **NOMINATIONS: NEW! All gilts showing at the Tulsa State Fair must mail in nomination packets to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2010. Nominations packets must include ear tag #, DNA sample, and nomination form. Nomination packets must be obtained from 4-H Extension Educator or FFA Instructor. For Animal Nomination and Entry Procedure, please refer to page # 92, rule # 43-49 in the General Junior Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.**
4. **OWNERSHIP:** All entries must be registered and recorded in the name of the exhibitor. No papers pending. All entries must have been owned, cared for daily and fed by the exhibitor before July 1.
5. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** All purebred gilts must have registration papers. Registration papers must be transferred into the name of the exhibitor by the respective breed association. Registration papers that are signed on the back by the respective breeder but not officially transferred into the exhibitors name by the breed association will not be accepted. Registration papers will be checked on Saturday, October 9, when the exhibitor checks in for the class. Must have original registration papers - no copies.
6. **SHOW LIMIT:** There is no limit on the number of gilts an exhibitor may enter. However, each exhibitor can only show a total of three (3) gilts, regardless of the number of head entered. Each exhibitor may exhibit in three breeds, but any one animal may not enter or show in two different breeds.
7. **SALE: NEW! The top 35 gilts will be required to sell in the Gilt Sale, a public auction of breeding gilts on Saturday, October 9, 2010. ALL GILTS SELECTED INTO THE GILT SALE MUST SELL – NO EXCEPTIONS. The top 10 Commercial gilts will sell. The number of gilts from the remaining breeds selected into the sale will be on a percentage basis of the total number shown with a minimum of 2 per breed. All gilts selected for the sale must provide a valid of a negative test for pseudorabies and brucellosis after June 1, 2010. All gilts selected to the sell will sell regardless of the number of gilts the exhibitor has in the sale. All gilts sell as is. A 15% commission will be collected from each gilt in the sale to assist the marketing of the event.**
8. **COMMERCIAL GILTS:** Commercial gilts will be shown by weight. The weight range is 220 pounds - 320 pounds. There will be a 10 pound weigh back for the top three in class. Weigh cards must be turned by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, October 8. Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head per class.
9. **PUREBRED GILTS:** Purebred classes will be broken by age by the Swine Committee. No gilts farrowed before January 1, 2010 or after April 30, 2010 will be allowed to show. There will be a minimum of 3 classes per breed. Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head per class.
10. If an animal is exhibited in the wrong class, that entry will be disqualified.
11. **EAR NOTCHES:** All gilts must be ear notched and healed.
12. **GROOMING:** Only water will be permitted in the holding ring. No color grooming compound will be allowed. If color is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor, organized group or individual involved will be disqualified and

barred from exhibiting for one year. These grooming rules apply for the duration of the Junior Division of the Tulsa State Fair to both sexes, all species.

13. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS:** No Substitutions are allowed in the Breeding Gilt Show.

14. **PENS:** Pens will be assigned by the designated superintendents by FFA Chapter and 4-H County. No pens will be built outside of barn.

15. **SCALES:** Each 4-H County or FFA Chapter will be allowed to purchase a scale permit by submitting a \$30 fee for each permit along with entries. All scales must be used at the end of the aisles. Scale stickers will be issued and must be placed on the upper, right hand corner at the back of the scale.

16. **PQA REQUIREMENTS:** Exhibitors will not be required to complete Pork Quality Assurance (PQA) or PQA Plus prior to the 2010 Tulsa State Fair; however all exhibitors are encouraged to do so. The Oklahoma Pork Council (OPC) will provide additional class premiums for those exhibitors with a current certification in PQA Plus on July 1, 2010. For gilts that place 1st in each class, OPC will add \$25 per gilt. OPC will also add \$50 to each breed champion gilt and \$25 to each reserve breed champion gilt. To be eligible for this special premium, the exhibitor of those gilts must be current in PQA Plus certification on July 1, 2010.

17. **PREMIUMS:** The Tulsa State Fair will award premiums on the following schedule.
