- Read Rules and Regulations:** All Junior Dairy Cattle exhibitors are subject to the Rules and Regulations governing the Open Dairy Cattle Show, General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, Animal Health Rules, and the Junior General Rules.
- Animal Eligibility:** Animals at the following levels of a genetic recovery program are ineligible to compete at the Tulsa State Fair: Ayrshire: 87%, Brown Swiss: ID (369 prefix), Guernsey: OA and PR, Holstein: 87%, Jersey: JI, OA and PR, Milking Shorthorn: 3600 and 3700
- Dress:** Junior exhibitors must wear a vest, shirt, T-shirt, sweatshirt or jacket of the appropriate color of the organization they represent. Dairy exhibitors may choose to show in white. An emblem of at least 2 1/2" of the organization they represent must be worn on their show attire.
- Class Breaks:** The following classes apply to all junior dairy breeds. The base date for computing ages for all breeds of Dairy Cattle are September 1 & March 1.

1. **Passes:** To receive gate passes, 4-H Educators or FFA Instructors must send the entry form to the TSF Livestock Office, P.O. Box 4735, Tulsa, OK 74159, or kara@tulsastatefair.com, by September 9, 2016.
2. **FFA Eligibility:** Competition is for 8th through 12th grades. A team will consist of (3) three and not more than 4 (four) members of the same Chapter.
3. **4-H Eligibility:** Juniors are members who have not reached their 14th birthday as of January 1 of the current calendar year. A team will consist of (3) three and not more than four (4) 4-H members from the same county or Extension unit. There will be no limitations on the number of teams from a club or county.
