**Released:** Gilts, except those selected for Gilt Sale, will be released upon conclusion of their breed show. Must be out by Sunday, October 9 at 12:00 noon.

**Entry Deadline:** Entry and payment must be submitted online by September 1, 2016, 12:00 midnight. Legal Release Form and Online Receipt must be postmarked mailed and by September 2, 2016. Nomination does not constitute entry.

**Processing Fee:** \$15.00

### SPECIAL RULES

1. **Read Rules and Regulations:** Exhibitor must comply with the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and the Health and Sanitary Regulations in the front of this book as well as Junior General Rules and Regulations.

2. **Eligibility:** The Tulsa State Fair Breeding Gilt Show and Sale is limited to Oklahoma 4-H and FFA members who have reached their ninth birthday and have a 4-H enrollment card on file in their respective County Extension Office on or before July 1 and 4-H/FFA members that have neither graduated from high school before May 2016 nor reached their 19th birthday before January 1, of the year of the show will be eligible to show. Oklahoma Pre-Juniors who are five by July 1, 2016 but not enrolled in 4-H are eligible to show.

3. **Nominations:** Gilts showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2016. For junior animal nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.

4. **Retag:** There will be a \$5.00 retag fee at the time of check-in if you have not retagged before the show.

5. **Ownership:** All entries must have been owned, cared for daily and fed by the exhibitor before July 1.


6. **Registration Papers:** All purebred gilts must have registration papers. Registration papers must be transferred into the name of the exhibitor by the respective breed association by the day of the show. Registration papers that are signed on the back by the respective breeder but not officially transferred into the exhibitors name by the breed association will not be accepted. No pending papers. Registration papers will be checked when the exhibitor checks in for the class. Must have original registration papers.

7. **Show Limit:** There is no limit on the number of gilts an exhibitor may enter. However, each exhibitor can only show a total of three (3) gilts, regardless of the number of head entered. Each exhibitor may exhibit in three breeds, but any one animal may not enter or show in two different breeds.

8. **Sale:** The top 45 gilts will be required to sell in the Gilt Sale, a public auction of breeding gilts on Saturday, October 8. All gilts selected into the gilt sale must sell – NO EXCEPTIONS. All breed champion and reserve breed champions will be selected to sell. The top 20 commercial gilts will sell. The judge will select the remaining sale spots from the purebreds. All gilts selected to the sell will sell regardless of the number of gilts an exhibitor has in the sale. All gilts sell as is. A 10% commission will be collected from each gilt in the sale to assist the marketing of the event.

9. **Commercial Gilts:** Commercial gilts will be shown by weight. The weight range is 230 pounds - 375 pounds. There will be a 10 pound weigh back for the top three in class. Weigh cards must be turned by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, October 7. Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head per class. The Superintendent will weigh commercial gilts prior to entering the main show ring.

10. **Purebred Gilts:** Purebred classes will be broken by age by the Swine Committee. No gilts farrowed before January 1, 2016 or after April 30, 2016 will be allowed to show. Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head per class.

11.  **Hereford Gilts:** There must be a minimum of 20 head shown for the Breed Champion and Reserve Breed Champion to qualify for the sale. This is the first year of a three year probation period. After three years, if the breed does not have 20 head to make a breed, then the Hereford Breed will be eliminated. Regardless of the number shown, Breed Champion and Reserve Breed Champion must show in the Grand Drive.

12. **Class:** If an animal is exhibited in the wrong class, that entry will be disqualified.

13. **Ear notch:** All gilts must be ear notched and healed.

14. **Grooming:** Only water will be permitted in the holding ring. No color grooming compound will be allowed. If color is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor, organized group or individual involved will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year. No washing outside of barn.

15. **Stalling:** Pens will be pre-assigned by the designated superintendent by FFA Chapter and 4-H Club. No pens will be built outside of barn. Divider panels are not provided by the show. You will need to bring your own divider panels and means to secure. Management reserved the right to reassign unused pens or tack pens to pen animals.

16. **PQA Requirements:** Exhibitors will not be required to complete Pork Quality Assurance (PQA) or PQA Plus prior to the 2016 Tulsa State Fair; however all exhibitors are encouraged to do so. As an incentive to participate in PQA Plus training programs, the Oklahoma Pork Council, (okPORK), will enter all exhibitors entered in the TSF Swine Shows who are current in Youth PQA plus in a

drawing for a chance to win 2 iPads AND will enter FFA Instructors and 4-H Extension Agents who conduct the PQA Plus training programs and have students entered in the TSF Swine Shows in a drawing for 2 \$500 Visa Gift Cards.

17. **Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$45, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$40, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$35, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$35, 6<sup>th</sup> - \$30, 7<sup>th</sup> - \$25, 8<sup>th</sup> - \$25, 9<sup>th</sup> - \$20, 10<sup>th</sup> - \$20
