SPECIAL RULES

- Read General Rules:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and Animal Health Regulations as well as the Junior General Rules and Regulations.
- Nominations:** Commercial Ewe Lambs showing at the Tulsa State Fair must have nomination information submitted online and mail DNA sample to the Tulsa State Fair office postmarked by July 1, 2017. For junior animal nomination and entry procedure, please refer to Junior General Rules and Regulations and the Nomination page on the Tulsa State Fair website.
- Ownership:** Exhibitor must have owned, cared for and fed daily the ewe from date of nomination.
- Teeth:** Must have lamb's teeth with no visible signs of permanent teeth.
- Show limit:** An exhibitor may show a total of three (3) commercial ewe lambs.
- Weigh Cards:** All weigh cards must be turned in by Saturday, September 30, 3:00 p.m.
- Retag:** There will be a \$5.00 retag fee if you have not retagged prior to arrival. Retags at the show will be at 1:00 p.m. Saturday.
- Fungus Inspection:** All sheep will be checked for fungus at check in. Blankets must be removed. Any sheep with fungus confirmed by the show veterinarian will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Tags:** Flock tags, tattoos, and/or registry association tags must be in the ear of the ewe NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Grooming:** Artificial coloring, paint, or powder will not be permitted for use on ewes during the entire show. If such is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor, organized group or individual involved will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year.
- Shearing:** All lambs must be slick shorn to the skin.
- Commercial Ewe Weight:** The minimum weight is 90 pounds. There is no maximum weight.
- Weigh Back:** Upon completion of each class, the Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top five (5) commercial ewes. Any ewe which has gained more than 5 pounds from the weight listed on the official weight card will be disqualified.
- Class Breaks:** Ewes will be divided into weight classes according to the following schedule:
