Entry Deadline: Junior Entries must be done online by **August 27, 2010**. Legal Release Form, Signed Receipt, and Payment must be mailed in and postmarked by September 3, 2010

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to enter until **September 17, 2010** for triple the fees.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All changes to the rules for the 2010 are in bold print

1. **READ GENERAL RULES:** All exhibitors will be required to follow the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics and the Health and Sanitary Regulations outlined in the front of this of this book as well as the Junior Division General Rules and Regulations.
2. **OWNERSHIP:** Exhibitor must have owned, cared for and fed daily does before July 1, 2010.
3. **SCRAPIE TAG OR TATTOO:** A scrapie tag or tattoo will be required on all breeding does at the time of the show. See the Health Rules in the front of this book.
4. **TEETH:** All doe kids may have lost their milk teeth at the time of the show; however, the two permanent insors must not have broke the gum line.
5. **HEALTH:** All animals must have a health certificate with scrapie and tattoo. Any animals with abscesses will NOT be allowed to remain on the fairgrounds. Goats must be free from external parasites, ringworms and warts.
6. **WEIGHT:** Minimum weight requirement for breeding does is 40 pounds. There is no official weigh-in of breeding does.
7. **WEIGH BACK:** Upon the completion of each class, the Superintendents will weigh a minimum of the top 5 does. Any doe which has gained more than 5 pounds from the weight on the weigh card will be disqualified.
8. **CLASS BREAKS:** Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head in each class.
9. **SHOW LIMITS:** Exhibitors may show a maximum of 3 Breeding Does.
10. **BRACING:** Bracing of animals will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal by the judge or superintendent. The animals must have all four feet on the ground. Animals must be shown with a collar used only to control the animal. Exhibitor can only briefly touch the animal with his body. Exhibitor can not use the collar to make the animal tense his muscles. Any violation will result in dismissal.
11. **SHEARING:** Length of hair is left up to the discretion of the exhibitor.
12. **HORNS:** Dehorning of goats in this show is not suggested, however horns should be tipped and rounded. Goats with horns sharper than deemed safe by Superintendent or Fair staff will be required to be tipped and rounded or isolated and not shown.
13. **BRED & OWNED:** To be eligible for the bred-and-owned class, the breeder and the owner of the animal must be one and the same. Registration papers will serve as proof for entering the class. All Junior Doe exhibitors must indicate if he/she would like to show in the bred-and-owned class at the time of check-in.
14. **SCALES:** Each 4-H County or FFA Chapter will be allowed to purchase a scale permit by submitting a \$30 fee for each permit along with entries. All scales must be used at the end of the aisles. Scale stickers will be issued and must be placed on the upper, right hand corner at the back of the scale.
15. **PREMIUMS:** Premiums will be mailed out and paid directly by the Tulsa State Fair.
