- Spring Yearling Heifers, Not In Milk: Born March 1 - May 31, 2009
- Winter Yearling Heifers, Not In Milk: Born December 1, 2008 - February 28, 2009
- Fall Yearling Heifers, Not In Milk: Born September 1 - November 30, 2008
- Junior 2 Year Old: Born March 1 - August 31, 2008
- Cows, 2 Years Old: Born September 1, 2007 - February 28, 2008
- Cows, 3 Years Old: Born September 1, 2006 - August 31, 2007
- Cows, 4 Years Old: Born September 1, 2005 - August 31, 2004
- Cows, 5 Years Old And Over: Born before September 1, 2004
