Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, may enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple head fees.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All changes to the rules for 2010 are in bold print

PROSPECT STEERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION.

1. The Prospect Steer Show is sponsored by the Oklahoma Club Calf Association. All rules of the OCCA and Tulsa State Fair apply. All breeds recognized by the OCCA will be eligible to show in the Prospect Steer Show. No minimum number required to make a breed
2. **READ GENERAL RULES:** Junior exhibitors are expected to adhere to the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring code of Ethics and Health and Sanitary Regulations in the front of this book as well as the Junior Division General Rules and Regulations.
3. **ARRIVAL:** Animals and tack will not be permitted in barns until barns are cleaned and ready. No animals permitted on grounds before 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, October 5.
4. **RELEASE:** All prospect steers will be released immediately following the prospect steer show on Wednesday, October 6, and must be out of barn by 7:00 pm. on Thursday, October 7. At this time you must move to the tieout area, or leave the grounds.
5. **OWNERSHIP:** Exhibitors must be the sole owner of any animals shown in his/her name and must have owned, cared for daily and fed steers.
6. **SHOW LIMIT:** No maximum on number of prospect steers an exhibitor may show. No steer will be allowed to show in two different breeds.
7. **ENTRIES:** All entries must be submitted online by FFA Instructor or 4-H County Extension Educator by August 27, 2010. **Signed entry receipt, legal release form, and correct payment must be postmarked by September 3.**
8. **STALLING:** Stall assignments will be posted at the Livestock office. We will be stalling by counties. Number of stalls requested must be accurate and will be checked.
9. **BEDDING:** All Junior Beef will be bedded on wood chips furnished by TSF with additional shavings available for purchase at the Feed Store located at the North end of the Explorer Barn. No straw will be permitted.
10. **WEIGH IN:** Scales will be available for weighing of prospect steers between 3:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 5, in the OK Ford Dealers Arena. Exhibitors will be responsible for declaring his/her animal's weight and turning in the "Official Show Weight Card" before 8:00 p.m. Maximum weight will be 1000 pounds.
11. **WEIGH BACK:** There will be a weigh-back in class of the top three steers with a 5% variance allowed.
12. **CLASS BREAKS:** Classes will be established after all steers are weighed. Classes will be posted in the livestock office. Prospect steer exhibitors must weigh their steers and turn weigh cards in by 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 5. Classes will be posted on Wednesday, October 6.

- 13. **FILLING:** The practice of artificial filling by pumping or any other device/procedure is prohibited.
- 14. **HAIR:** No alteration or simulation with respect to color or hair will be permitted on any Junior animals. (This includes all products, natural or man-made, false switch permitted.) If alteration or addition is detected by a show official or through a protest, the exhibitor will be disqualified and barred from exhibiting for one year. These grooming rules apply for the duration of the Tulsa State Fair, to steers and heifers.
- 15. **GENERATORS:** No generators will be allowed in the barn or parking area.
- 16. **GROOMING CHUTES:** Due to limited space, ONLY 1 grooming chute for every 5 beef cattle entries, (steer and heifer) per 4-H & FFA County will be permitted on the TSF grounds. Grooming chute passes may be purchased for \$30 at the time of entry. Due to safety issues, grooming chutes will ONLY be permitted in the stall area. No grooming chutes allowed in the aisles or outside of the Expedition Barn or Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn.
- 17. **SCALES:** Each 4-H County or FFA Chapter will be allowed to purchase a scale permit by submitting a \$30 fee for each permit along with entires. All scales must be used at the end of the aisles. Scale stickers will be issued and must be placed on the upper, right hand corner at the back of the scale.
- 18. **VIOLATION OF RULES:** Any violation of the Rules and Regulations incorporated in this Premium List, the Show Ring Code of Ethics and Junior Division Rules and Regulations may result in forfeiture of all premiums and awards, disqualification, expulsion or probation of the exhibitor, organized group the exhibitor represents, any individual and the exhibitor or livestock involved. Probation, disqualification, expulsion, or other disciplinary action of the Fair Management will be final. Such action will require application for readmission under such terms as the Management may prescribe before the group or individual is allowed to exhibit at future events. All medications will be administered by licensed veterinarians only.
- 19. **BREEDS:** All breeds sanctioned with the OCCA will be eligible to show in the Tulsa State Fair Prospect Steer Show. (American, Angus, Braunvieh, Charolais, Chianina, Crossbred, Gelbvieh, Hereford, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Salers, Shorthorn, and Simmental).
- 20. **PREMIUMS:** All entry fees will be paid back in class premiums.
