Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010. Entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

Entry Extension: Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals and classes at double head fees and double class fees until **September 17, 2010**.

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple head fees and triple class fees.

Substitutions: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Each Superintendent must finalize their show information by noon the day preceding their show. No changes will be made after this time.
2. **SANCTIONING:** This Llama Show is an ALSA approved show. All rules and guidelines for this show will be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Tulsa State Fair, and the 15th Edition ALSA Handbook. Exhibitors are responsible for familiarizing themselves with these rules and regulations.
3. **FEES:** Processing fees of \$40.00 must be paid on each halter class entered and \$20.00 for all performance and group classes entered. No processing fee or premium paid on showmanship classes. Youth must make showmanship entry on separate entry blank.
4. **REGISTRATION:** All breeding llamas 13 months and older entered in approved classes with the exception of youth classes, must be registered or have passed screening with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). Non-breeder llamas do not have to be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or CLRC except those recorded with ALSA and participating in the Award system. Breeding llamas entered in the 5 months through 12 months age divisions should at least have a copy of application pending. Copies of registration papers must be sent in with the entry form.
5. **NON-BREEDER HALTER:** Llamas entered in Non-Breeder Halter classes must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying they are geldings, vasectomized males, or spayed or non-productive females.
6. **ALSA FEES:** This is an ALSA (Alpaca and Llama Show Association) sanctioned and supported llama show, therefore, a \$30.00 per person (youth or adult) fee will be assessed to NON-ALSA participants. ALSA and NON-ALSA participants pay a \$5.00 per animal fee as well. Do not send the fee or animal fee to the Tulsa State Fair - both fees will be collected at check-in.
7. **ALSA #:** Please note each animal's ALSA number on your application if you wish ALSA points.
8. **HEALTH:** All animals must be accompanied by an individual health certificate stating that the animal is free of infections or contagious disease issued within 30 days prior to arrival.
9. **STALLS:** Llamas will be in stalls approximately 9'x9' on hard surface.
10. **ANIMAL AGE:** Base date for determining age is October 8, 2010.
11. **YOUTH AGE:** All youth between the ages of 8-18 as of January 1 of this year may show in ALSA approved YOUTH classes, labeled as Junior, Intermediate or Senior. The YOUTH division of 4-7 years, labeled as Sub-Junior, does not receive ALSA points. To qualify for YOUTH ALSA points, the youth(8-18) must be an ALSA member. Points go to the youth not the llama with the exception of Young Pack. You do not have to be an ALSA member to show in these classes. Youth must have written permission from parent, project leader, 4-H advisor or FFA advisor to participate in the youth events.
12. **BRED & OWNED:** Bred and Owned - This class is for breeding quality animals whose dam was owned by the exhibitor when the dam was bred and when the animal was born and both are still owned by the exhibitor.
13. **PERFORMANCE:** The Open Performance and Youth Performance classes have been arranged to make the best use of obstacle course materials, the arena and time.
14. **PICTURES:** Champion and Reserve Champion animals from each breed must be taken to the back drop for photographs immediately following completion of each day's show.
