Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010. Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

Entry Extension: Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 17, 2010**.

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple the head fees.

Substitutions: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

Processing Fee: Open Braunvieh \$45 per head.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Superintendent must finalize show information by noon the day preceding their show. No changes will be made after this time.

1. All premiums will be paid to exhibitors by the Tulsa State Fair. The Braunvieh Association will contribute \$750.00 towards the premiums offered. Added premium from advertisers and breeders of Braunvieh cattle in show brochure.
2. All Exhibitors are expected to follow the International Association of Fairs and National Code of Show Ring Ethics, as well as following the general set forth by the Tulsa State Fair.
3. Animals competing in the Braunvieh Show must be duly recorded in the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herd Book.
4. Exhibitors must be in good standing with the Braunvieh Association of America.
5. Exhibitors must comply with the rules and guidelines of each show and entity.
6. All animals exhibited must have a know Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its' Braunvieh parent(s).
7. Animals may be Fullblood or Purebred (7/8 Braunvieh blood for females and 15/16 Braunvieh blood for males) to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh Show. Animals with less than purebred Braunvieh blood, and 1/4 or greater Braunvieh blood, will be shown in a separate Braunvieh Beef Builder/Percentage show. (All fractions based on breed up percentages.)
 - a. Beef Builder/Percentage/American Cross animals will be broken by breed up percentages and number of animals entered. 1/2 bloods and higher will be shown as a high percentage, 1/4 to 3/8 will be shown as low percentage.
 - b. Any category which has 20 or more entries will be shown separately. Any and all categories with 19 or less entries will show together.
 - c. In each respective percentage division, if 10 head or more shown will allow for class breaks, 9 or less, all animals will show as one class
8. The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPDs) values, ultrasound data (collected by a certified technician), scrotal circumference for bulls, weights and ratios for performance and weights with weight-per-day of age. Performance figures, (including weights, hip heights, and frame scores), can be presented in their entirety or any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.
9. Class 20 - Senior Yearling Females, can show with calves at side and still be eligible to show for champion female/heifer.
10. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older (not females in cow/calf class) must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection. Heifers 28 months or older must have a calf by side.
11. Females born prior to September 1, 2008 must show in the cow/calf class with a calf at side. The pair will not be eligible for champion female/heifer. Calves from the cow/calf class can be entered as individuals in the show.
12. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. The certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months and older will have a nose ring to be shown
13. Braunvieh entries will not be entered in a specific show class at time of entry.
14. Altering animals natural color will not be allowed, violation will result in disqualification.
15. No cosmetic surgeries other than surgical dehorning will be allowed, violation will result in disqualification.

16. Only generally accepted fitting practices will be allowed. Violation will be cause for disqualification. Show committee will make ruling on case by case basis. Animals disqualified will forfeit entry fees, awards and show points. Appeals will be forwarded to ethics committee and Executive Vice President.
17. Protests will be made to Show committee with a \$150.00 protest fee, within 24 hours of show or prior to release, whichever is first, in writing to BAA staff or show committee member. In ruling in favor of protest, fee will be refunded. If ruling against, fee will be forfeited.
18. Appeals will be made to Show committee with a \$150 appeal fee. Appeal will be forwarded with all information to ethics committee and Executive Vice President. If appeal granted, fee will be returned with reinstatement of show points and any other forfeited entry fees and awards. If appeal denied, fee will be forfeited.
19. Decision of ethics committee and Executive Vice President will be final.
