**Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010.** Open Show entries may be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

**Entry Extension:** Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 17, 2010.**

**Late Entries:** Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple the head fees.

**Substitutions:** Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The Superintendent must finalize show information by noon the day preceding the show. No changes will be made after this time.
1. The American Dexter Cattle Association (ADCA) pays 20% of total premium money in the Dexter classes. All premiums will be paid by the Tulsa State Fair.
2. Any additional prize money and awards will be paid/given directly from the Oklahoma Dexter Cattle Association – to the winner; amounts to be posted on the ADCA website at [www.dextercattle.org](http://www.dextercattle.org) by September 1, 2010.
3. Owners of exhibited animals must be current members of the American Dexter Cattle Association.
4. All animals must be properly identified using ear tags, neck chains, brands, etc., and must be legibly tattooed with the exact alpha-numeric identification that appears on the registration papers.
5. All animals must be halter broke to lead and must be manageable. Unmanageable animals will be asked to leave the show ring and will not be eligible for any premium.
6. All animals must be registered with the American Dexter Cattle Association prior to entry. Calves under 6 months of age that are to be shown in cow/calf class do not need to be registered. Note: Unregistered calves are not eligible to be shown in individual classes.
7. Health certificates will be required for all entries and will be checked by the designated show veterinarian.
8. All bulls 12 months and older must have an affixed nose ring or nose clamp.
9. To compete in the showmanship category, the exhibitor must have received a showmanship button while exhibiting their animal in this show.
10. If an exhibitor wins first in more than one class with different animals, they may request someone to show the additional animal(s) during the Grand and Reserve Grand competitions.
11. All animals must be washed and brushed. Additional grooming is left up to the discretion of the owner as long as they abide by the items that are prohibited.

**Prohibited Grooming Items**

- a. Painting or polishing of horns or hooves with colored polish
  - b. Artificial coat coloring
  - c. Growth implants
  - d. Drugs to alter the disposition of the animal
  - e. Total body fitting – which includes sculpting of the hair when clipping and using adhesives, wax or mousse to shape the coat to hide animal flaws.
12. Showmanship attire will be required and enforced in the show ring for any person presenting cattle.
    - a. Collared/buttoned shirts with sleeves (length of the sleeves is determined by the season/weather)
    - b. Long pants (jeans or slacks) that are dark and don't have tears or holes.
    - c. Boots or fully enclosed heavy footwear must be worn for safety reasons.
    - d. Optional – Belt, western hats, gloves or the use of show sticks and combs
    - e. Prohibited items:
      - i. Baseball caps
      - ii. T-shirts or crop top shirts that leave the midriff skin showing
      - iii. Sandals or canvas shoes (for safety reasons)
      - iv. Overalls
      - v. Baggy, low riding pants that drag on the ground (for safety reasons)
