**Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010.** Open Show entries may be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27 .

**Entry Extension:** Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 17, 2010**.

**Late Entries:** Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple the head fees.

**Substitutions:** Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Oklahoma Gelbvieh Association will pay 20% of the liability premiums. All premiums will be paid by the Tulsa State Fair.

1. The Superintendent must finalize the show information by noon the day preceding the show. No changes will be made after this time.
2. A copy of your entries, PLUS an additional \$20.00 per head is due at time of entry. Send to: OGA c/o Randy Gallaway, Sec./Treas., 15182 North Midwest Blvd., Mulhall, OK 73063.
3. All cattle entered in this show must be registered with the American Gelbvieh Association. If you have any 75% Gelbvieh animals that could possibly be entered either in Purebred or Balancer classes, you must declare at the time of entry either purebred or balancer classes you desire to enter. There will be separate Purebred and Balancer classes.
4. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline date. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (in the individual classes).
5. Purebred and percentage females 75% Gelbvieh to 100% will show together. No age limit on cows in the cow/calf pairs. Percentage females must be entered either in Purebred or Balancer classes. They will not be allowed to enter or show in both Purebred and Balancer classes. For example, a registered 75% Gelbvieh female that is designated purebred by the exhibitor may show in the purebred show but will not be allowed to show in the balancer or balancer group classes.
6. Purebred, 7/8's Gelbvieh to 100% Gelbvieh bulls will show together. No age limit on bulls. Percentage bulls must be entered either in Purebred or Balancer classes. They will not be allowed to enter or show in both Purebred and Balancer classes. For example, a registered 7/8's Gelbvieh bull that is designated purebred by the exhibitor may show in the purebred show but will not be allowed to show in the balancer or balancer group classes.
7. All animals must be properly tattooed, including herd prefix and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and must match registration papers.
8. All females 18 months or older must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule safe-in-calf will apply to a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the current year, as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or embryologist.
9. No Heifers over 30 mo. of age.
10. All cows shown in Cow/Calf classes with a calf over 180 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Age of calf must not exceed 240 days as of date of the show. Calf must be cow's natural calf, not embryo transplant.
11. Calf may show in individual class (regular entry fee required).
12. Bulls 12 months of age and older must be shown with a noselead. A noselead must be worn when the bull is removed from his stall.
13. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show superintendent and the show management.
14. There is NO limit to the number of individual entries in each class and NO limit to the number of premiums paid an individual owner in each class.
15. No surgical procedures allowed except for dehorning. Violation of AGA rules regarding defects and unethical practices will result in disqualification of animal in question.
16. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have animals in the ring at the time of judging.

17. All animals shown in the group classes must have been shown in their respective single age class.

18. Cows exhibited in the cow/calf classes are ineligible for group classes. Champion Cow/Calf eligible for Grand Champion Female.

19. Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors and subsequently entered in Open classes will be treated as family entries in group classes.

20. All protests against exhibitors, dealing with age or genetic background of show cattle, must be made in writing and signed by 5 active members of the Oklahoma Gelbvieh Association and accompanied by a deposit of \$500.00 in cash or certified check (which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained). Such protest must state plainly the cause of complaint, and then presented to the show superintendent at least 12 hours before the start of the show.

**CLASSES:** All classes will be split by age upon receipt of all entries. Classes will be as nearly uniform in size as possible. Classes will be paid using the premium A scale. There will be separate classes for Purebred and Balancer's. Any animal that may qualify for both Purebred and Balancer will not be allowed to show in both classes. **The exhibitor must choose purebred or balancer at the time of entry.**

**GROUP CLASSES: All animals must have been shown in individual classes.** Purebred and Balancer Classes will have separate Group classes. Classes will be paid using the premium B Scale.

Pair of Calves: 2 animal, both sexes represented, owned or co-owned by exhibitor

Pair of Yearlings: 2 animals, both sexes represented, owned or co-owned by exhibitor

Produce of Dam: 2 animals out of the same dam. No ownership requirements. No more than one entry will be permitted to show from one dam. No embryo transfers.

Embryo Produce of Dam: 2 animals, the produce of one donor. No ownership requirements, may both be embryo produced or embryo and one natural born.

Get of Sire: 3 animals same sire, both sexes represented. No ownership requirements. Must be born from at least two different dams.

Best Three Head: 3 animals owned or co-owned by the exhibitor

Premier Exhibitor: When no rule is specified here we will follow the rules set at National Gelbvieh Show.
