Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010. Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

Entry Extension: Entries received prior to August 27, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 17, 2010**.

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple head fees.

Substitutions: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Superintendent must finalize their show information by noon the day preceding their show. No changes will be made after this time.
2. The Oklahoma Red Angus Association will pay 20% of the liability premiums. All premiums will be paid by the Tulsa State Fair.
3. Only registered Red Angus cattle in Category 1A (100%) and Category 1B (87% through 99%) will be eligible to show. This specifically excludes cattle in Category II and III. The Tulsa State Fair Red Angus Show will be conducted under a joint show provision wherein Category 1A and 1B show together in the same classes.
4. All animals entered must conform to all the Tulsa State Fair and the Red Angus Association of America eligibility requirements.
5. Red Angus cattle must be officially registered in one of the following: Red Angus Association Herdbook, in the Herdbook of the Canadian Angus Association or any foreign Angus Association Herdbook recognized by the Red Angus Association of America and have available for inspection by show officials at the Tulsa State Fair.
6. Animals entered must have been registered in the name of the person entering no less than 30 days prior to the show.
7. Entries in classes at any Red Angus show are accepted with the understanding that each exhibitor agrees to conform to the rules and regulations of the Red Angus Association of America with reference to inspection of entries, such as blood typing, mousing and such other inspections prescribed by the Red Angus Association of America.
8. All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and must match the registration certificate. If an animal's tattoo is not legible or does not match the registration certificate and cannot be read during processing, it will not be allowed to participate in the show.
9. Each exhibitor and/or owner of Red Angus cattle entered in any Red Angus show or exhibition is required to ensure that each animal will be exhibited in its natural conformation and structure and without any alterations or modifications, with the exception of acceptable fitting, grooming and treatment of hooves.
10. The addition of any hair or hair-like substances shall be considered an unethical practice and will not be allowed in Red Angus Competition.
11. All females 20 months of age or older (on announced date of show) exhibited at a show sponsored by the Red Angus Association of America must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian or have produced fertile eggs as certified in a written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist or have a calf at side. Failure to show documentation will result in the animal being ineligible to show.
12. All bulls 9 months of age or older (on announced date of show) exhibited at a show sponsored by the Red Angus Association of America must be shown with a nose lead.
13. Each exhibitor and/or owner of Red Angus entering in any Red Angus show or exhibition is subject to the "Declaration of Participation" in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Red Angus Association of America.

GROUP CLASSES

60. <u>Senior Get-of-Sire</u>		(Rosette)
Four animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.		
61. <u>Junior Get-of-Sire</u>		(Rosette)
Three animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, year prior to beginning of show year. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes		

- 62. Produce-of-Dam (Rosette)
Two animals, either or both sexes, both shown in their respective classes. Animals shown in this class need not be owned by the exhibitor.
- 63. Premier Breeders Class (Banner)
Will be computed from breeder's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st, 2 points for each 2nd, 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.
- 64. Premier Exhibitor Class (Banner)
Will be computed from breeder's placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st, 2 points for each 2nd, 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.
