**Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010.** Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online must be posted by 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

**Entry Extension:** Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals double head fees until **September 17, 2010**.

**Late Entries:** Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple head fees.

**Substitution:** Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PUREBRED & PERCENTAGE SHOWS**

1. Each Superintendent must finalize the show information by noon the day preceding the show. No changes will be made after this time.
2. A copy of your entries, PLUS and additional \$10.00 per head is due at the time of entry. Send to: Oklahoma Simmental Association, c/o Russell Martin, 6730 N. 4010 Rd. Copan, OK 74022.
3. The Open Purebred Simmental Show will begin at 1:00 p.m., Sunday October 4, 2009 and the Open Percentage Simmental Show will start immediately following the Open Purebred Simmental Show.
4. All purebred and percentage animals exhibited must be registered in the name of the exhibitor in the American Simmental Association Herdbook. In the Open Purebred Show, heifers must be 3/4 or more. Bulls must be purebred. In the Open Percentage Show, heifers and bulls must not be lower than 1/2 or more than 3/4 blood. All percentage Simmental cattle must be registered with the American Simmental Association and have at least one parent, sire or dam, that is also registered.
5. No class shall have more than 15 cattle per class. Any class more than 15 will be split into smaller classes containing eight (8) or more but less than 16. Age classes split into two or more classes will be paid premium as listed in the premium list. All classes will be lined up by age in the show ring.
6. Each animal must be accompanied by an individual health certificate according to state and federal health requirements.
7. It is recommended that exhibitor and breeder be defined as follows: Where a herd is registered in the name of different members of a family residing on one farm and where the herd is one unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for the Oklahoma Special'. An additional \$10 for each entry will be charged, and must be paid directly to the Oklahoma Simmental Simbrah Association.
8. The Tulsa State Fair will furnish 75% of the premiums and the Oklahoma Simmental Simbrah Association 25%, but all premiums will be paid to exhibitors by the Tulsa State Fair. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Tulsa State Fair.
