Begin Arrival: Wednesday, September 29, 12:00 noon.

In Place: Thursday, September 30, 12:00 noon.

Judging: Friday, October 1, 8:00 a.m.

Begin Release: Staged Release on Saturday, October 2.

All Out: Sunday, October 3, 10:00 p.m.

Entry Deadline: August 27, 2010. Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online must be posted by 12:00 midnight on August 27. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 27.

Entry Extension: Entries received prior to August 27, 2010, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 17, 2010**.

Late Entries: Entries not received prior to August 27, 2010, can enter until **September 17, 2010**, for triple the head fees.

Substitutions: Substitution of animals will be accepted until noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

Processing Fee: Youth Texas Longhorn \$35 per head.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Superintendent must finalize the show information by noon, the day preceding the show.
2. Entries and a \$35 fee per entry must be sent to the Tulsa State Fair, P.O. Box 4735, Tulsa, OK 74159 or submitted online at www.tulsastatefair.com.
3. The TLBT World Qualifying Youth Texas Longhorn Show is open to cattle registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America, 2315 N. Main Street, Suite 402, Ft. Worth, Texas 76106. However, cattle are not required to be registered in the name of the exhibiting youth.
4. All youth must be members in good standing with the Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow (TLBT). Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Tulsa State Fair, TLBAA and the TLBT. The signing of the the entry form by the exhibitor implies agreement to abide by all the rules and regulations governing the TLBT World Show Circuit as stated in the TLBAA World Show Circuit Official Handbook. Copies of the rules and regulations can be obtained from the TLBAA, 2315 N. Main, Suite 402, Fort Worth, Texas 76106. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation or not abiding by the show rules will be disqualified from showing.
5. All animals, except calves beside dam, must be registered with the TLBAA and a copy of the original registration certificate must be presented to the superintendent for verification prior to the show. No pending registrations will be accepted.
6. All bulls are required to be shown with a nose lead.
7. Exhibitors must wear western attire, long sleeve shirt or long sleeve blouse with collar and cuffs and pants or skirt with boots, while exhibiting cattle in the show ring.

Showmanship Classifications

Pee Wee: EXHIBITION CLASS: Youth six years and younger may show calves, male or female. This is the only class that will allow adults in the show ring.

Division I: Junior Showmanship. Exhibitors 7-9 years of age as of January 1, 2010.

Division II: Intermediate Showmanship. Exhibitors 10-12 years of age as of January 1, 2010.

Division III: Teen Showmanship. Exhibitors 13-15 years of age as of January 1, 2010.

Division IV: Senior Showmanship: Exhibitors 16-18 years of age as of January 1, 2010. The top age limit for the Senior Division will be 18 years or the year of gradation from high school. (Seniors may not show following the National Show the year of their graduation.)

In Showmanship Classes youth must exhibit an animal that was shown in competition in the TLBT Show.
